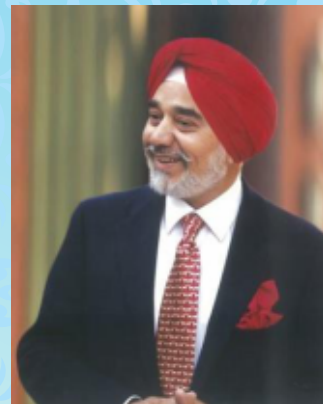

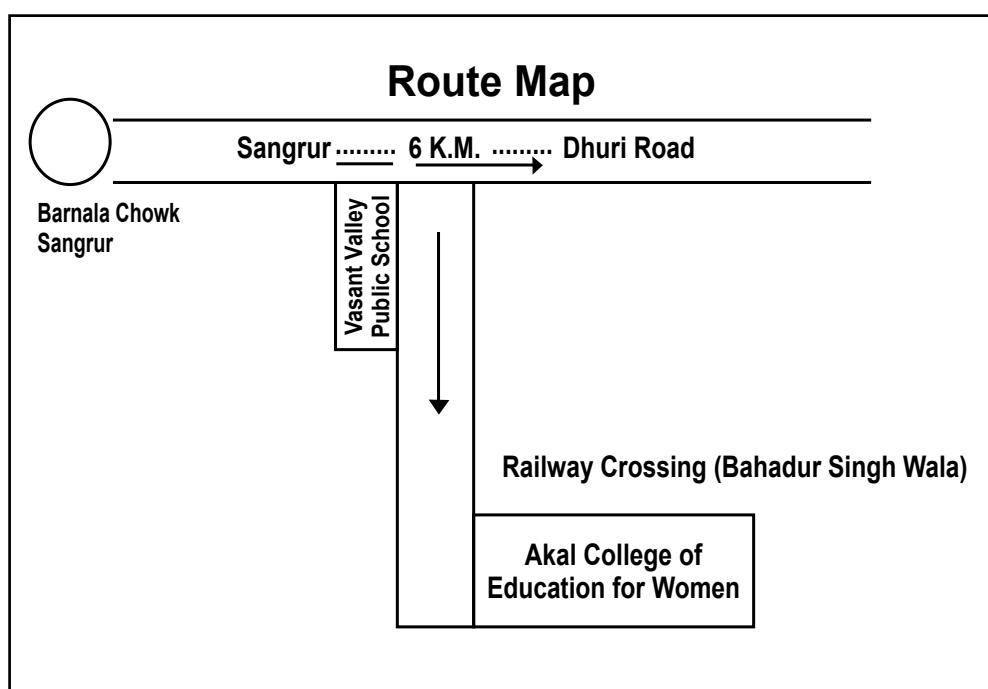
ABOUT THE BUILDING

- The institution has been set up with infrastructure facilities far exceeding the NCTE norms. The total area of institution is 6 acres. It has been set up in a double storeyed building.
- The First block comprises Principal's Office, Administrative Office, Staff Room, Visitor Room, Seminar/Assembly Hall, Music, Art & Craft Room.
- The Second block comprises Director Office, Examination Cell, IQAC, NSS Office, Classrooms, Washrooms, Health Club/Table Tennis Hall and Dispensary.
- The Third block is upstairs where Communication skill development Lab, library with seating capacity of 40 students, Science Lab, Computer Lab, S.St. Resource Centre, Alumni Office, Teaching Aid Fabricating Room, Mathematics Lab, Worship room, Yoga Room, Guidance & Placement Cell, Language Resource Centre, Psychology Lab, Washrooms (Staff) and Projector-cum-Smart Class Room are situated.
- The college grounds and the multipurpose hall are used for curricular and co-curricular activities.
- Institution has all facilities to impart computer education to students.
- Proper arrangement of potable water is made. R.O. system is placed.
- Facility of Girls common room, canteen, generator room and a store room is in addition to the college block.
- An auditorium with seating capacity of 500 persons.

LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE

The College is situated on the outskirts of village Fatehgarh Chhanna on the Sangrur Dhuri Road. A turn alongside the Vasant Valley Public School takes you to the campus in five minutes. It is just behind Bahadur Singh Wala Railway Station and barely six kms. from Sangrur city. It has clean and healthy environment, placed as it is in the lap of nature, newly constructed and has all modern amenities.

STAFF

The staff of the college is highly qualified, experienced, dedicated and university approved. Their ability is a proven fact because during the last ten sessions the college result had been cent percent and the discipline had been excellent.

BUS-SERVICE

College has its own bus. Conveyance facility is available from Sangrur to College.

HOSTEL

The College has its own hostel at the Campus of Akal Degree College for Women Sangrur, only six kms. from the college campus. It is supervised by the college authorities. It is equipped with modern facilities such as 24 hours supply of electricity, potable water, cosy and airy rooms, fine arrangement for mess. It has its own Generator set of 62.5 kw.

GUIDANCE CELL

In order to help the students in general matters of choice, selection, competition tests etc. a guidance cell under the stewardship of experienced teachers has been established in the college. The students are free to discuss their problems with the teachers.

PLACEMENT CELL

A placement cell under the supervision of experienced teachers has been set up in the college to help students to get employment.

COMMON ROOM AND CANTEEN

Common room is well furnished. Water Cooler with RO System and other facilities are available. Students can interact with one another freely not only to know each other but also to think upon their future career.

SHRC (Sexual Harassment Redressal Cell)

This cell addresses the sexual harassment related complaints, The Cell Comprises of Director, Principal and Professors.

ANTI RAGGING CELL

Has been set up in the college and comprises of Directors, Principal and Experienced Professors.

LABS

The college is enriched with well equipped laboratories of Psychology, Computer Science, Science, Mathematics & S.St.

LANGUAGE LAB

To update the students in pronunciation and understanding of English language College has a well equipped language lab. It has latest available projectors enabling the teachers to display & Project their lessons effectively. Teachers are duty bound to use these different gadgets in the laboratory. It has study skills success with Sky pronunciation software.

HEALTH CLUB & YOGA ROOM

The college takes special interest in the Physical health of its students. For this purpose there is a well equipped health club and yoga room containing required gadgets.

EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY LABORATORY

College has separate ET Lab. where over head projector (OHP), Multimedia Projector, Slide Projector and other such gadgets related to teaching have been installed to impart visual training to students.

TUTORIALS

For monitoring the work and progress of the students and to provide intimate personal contact with teachers, regular tutorial present one heed.

SMART CLASS ROOM

To make the prospective teachers aware about the latest technology, an interactive board has been installed in the college where the prospective teachers are trained to use it for effective teaching.

DISPENSARY

There is provision of well ventilated dispensary which is equipped with medicines. Immediate medical aid is provided to the students in case of emergency.

MULTIPURPOSE HALL

College has very beautiful newly constructed multipurpose hall with seating capacity of 500 persons.

GAMES AND SPORTS

College has its own vast play grounds along with 200m track. There is a provision for games like Volleyball, Badminton, Kho-Kho and Table Tennis etc. Regular Yoga Classes are held in separate Yoga Room. Extension lectures are arranged in liaison with the University authorities.

EXCURSION AND EDUCATIONAL TOURS/TRIPS

In order to stimulate national and emotional integration and a sense of responsibility, excursions and educational tours to places of historical and geographical importance are a part of the B.Ed. curriculum and therefore each student has to participate in these excursion/tours.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Various Co-curricular activities including celebration of national and international days are organised in the college. Students take active part in these co-curricular activities. Teams are sent in inter-college competitions and youth festival organised by Punjabi University, Patiala.

LIBRARY

The Library is the seat of learning. The college has well equipped library with a collection of wide variety of books, encyclopedias, journals, magazines, newspapers and research publications. Library is fully automated with ultra soft e-lib software.

ADMISSION

Admission to B.Ed. course is based on the merit prepared by one of the state Universities Punjab University Chandigarh, Punjabi Univesity Patiala & GNDU Amritsar. The intake capacity of the college for B.Ed. is 100 seats only.

COLLEGE DUES

1. Admitted Candidates who do not pay their dues on the due date (to be notified at the time of interview) will forfeit right to the admission.
2. Candidates from a University other than the Punjabi University may be admitted provisionally if they are otherwise eligible and fulfill the requirement of the regulation concerning the examination. This will, however be subject to the confirmation by the Punjabi University. Such candidates are required to submit the following documents within 15 days from the admission, failing which they will have to pay late fee as per Punjabi University, Rules.
 - (a) Original certificates of the examinations passed.
 - (b) Migration certificate

The selected candidates shall be required to deposit the fee and annual charges as per the norms and fee structure of Punjabi University Patiala.

GENERAL RULES

1. Regularity and punctuality in attendance of classes and house examinations is absolutely essential for all the students.
2. Students are not allowed to keep mobile phones.
3. No student will be allowed to accept any employment during the course of training.
4. The College enforces simplicity in dress. Wearing of any kinds of ornaments is discouraged.
5. A student is liable to be reprimanded on the grounds like misbehavior, breach of discipline and disobeying college/hostel rules.
6. Refund of securities is permissible within six months of the declaration of university results.
7. The college authorities follow strict rules of conduct for the students. The students are required to attend the morning assembly and stay at the college campus for full time.

8. The visiting hours for general public and parents to meet the Principal are from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.
9. Dress Code of the college is observed.
10. Ragging is banned in the College.

RAGGING IS BANNED

The University Grants Commission vide its letter no. F1-16-2018 (CPP II) dated June 17, 2009 has reiterated the ban on ragging of students in Institutions of Higher Learning.

FORMS OF RAGGING

Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, excitement by rough or rude treatment or handling, including rowdy undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehensive fear in fresher, or asking the students to do any act or perform something which a student will not do in the ordinary course or which causes him/her shame of embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc.

Punishment for Participation in/or abetment of Ragging:

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test./examination or other evaluation process
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for period varying from 1 to 4 Semester of equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
10. Fine up to Rs.25,000/

LEAVE RULES

The College observes strict procedure for the grant of leave to day-scholars as well as resident students.

1. Leave must be got sanctioned personally before it is availed. Leave application must reach the tutor concerned well in advance. In case of illness, the application must be supported by the medical certificate.
2. Leave for more than three days or leave during examination days will be granted only by the Principal.
3. Application of hostel students for sick leave will be recommended by the Superintendent of the hostel.
4. If a student remains absent for more than ten days continuously, her name will be struck off from the College rolls. Re-admission is not permissible.

HOUSE EXAMINATION ATTENDANCE

1. House test will be held twice a Semester.
2. Exemption from house examinations will not be given under any circumstances.
3. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who remain absent during the house examination.
4. The internal assessment of the students who fail to appear in house examination will not be sent to the university.

LIBRARY RULES

1. Library books will be issued on library card only.
2. Loss of library card should immediately be reported to the librarian who will issue a duplicate card on payment of Rs. 50/-.
3. Four books will be issued to a student for a period of 14 days.
4. The books will be re-issued if they are not in demand by other students.
5. Reference books, text books, rare books & periodicals shall not be issued. These are for consultation in the Library.

6. Books issued from the Library should in no case be underlined and disfigured. If the book is already damaged in any form, it should be got checked by the librarian.
7. The students are expected to observe perfect silence in the reading room.
8. Books to needy students will be issued for whole year from book bank.
